Communication & Language

We will look at pictures of dinosaurs and discuss differences and similarities. We will be thinking about sequence of events in stories and saying what happened in the beginning, middle and end. We will listen to our friends talk.



Literacy

We will continue with our daily Phonics lessons where the children will practice to read and write words as well as sentences. Our Drawing Club books will be topic related and the children will continuously improve their drawings and captions.

Maths

In Spring Term, the children will explore the composition of numbers 5-10. We will look at equal and unequal sets as well as doubles.



Physical Development
