Communication & Language

This term we are going to learn new vocabulary relating our seaside topic and use these in different context. They will engage in rhymes, songs and listen to high quality texts.



Reading

We will continue to practice and learn new Phonics sounds through reading and writing. The children have access to fiction and non-fiction texts relating to our topic and will participate in daily story times.



Maths

Children will consolidate their learning to get ready for the next school year. We will look at time and clocks, practise our teen numbers to 100 and create patterns. We will continue to learn how to subitise amounts.

Physical Development

During Physical Education, the children will play different beach sport activities whilst practising important skills, such as throwing, catching, or jumping.

Understanding the world

This term, we will explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties. The children will talk about what they see and recognise some environments that are different from the one in which they live.

The children will recognise that people have different beliefs and understand that some places are special to members of their community. We will think about homes and the natural world as well as Churches, Mosques and Synagogues

Expressive Art and Design

The children will increasingly match the pitch and follow the melody. We will explore and engage in music making, dance and performing. We will create boats with different materials and talk about textures, patterns and materials. We will use clay, paint and junk modelling to create seaside art and craft. We will make a wax resist picture.

How to help your child

- Phonics: Reading and writing green words and red words and sentences.
- Reading and writing their first name (capital letter and small letters).
- Story time: Talk about things that happened in a story. Pointing out 'green words' which appear in the story.
- Counting to 100 and highlighting the teen numbers.
- Pointing out the time when events happen (lunch, dinner, bedtime, etc.).

Personal & Social Development

Relating to our topic, we will talk about keeping safe at the seaside, including sun safety and water safety.

We will explore life cycles of plants and animals and we will briefly explore human life-cycles, including growing from babies to children.


