#### Writing

Our writing this term will be linked to the book 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna. We will look at reading between the lines of the story and what the author and illustrators have implied. We will write our own story as well as letters and poems.



#### Reading

We will also be looking at the novel 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' in our whole class shared reading sessions. Through discussions, we will think about the characters in the story and how we find out more about their back story as we read the novel. We will discuss how our thoughts and opinions change through comprehension



#### Maths

This term we will be finishing our work on fractions. We will look at how to subtract from a mixed number, as well as multiplying and dividing fractions. We will then move on to look at percentages and ratio and how these link to fractions.

## Art



