
Feast of Flowers, Fruits and Seeds Knowledge Organiser Y3-4 Term 6

Key Knowledge

- I know the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers
- I know what plants need for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how these vary from plant to plant
- I know the way in which water is transported within plants
- I can explain the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.


