Moonstone class were also very engaged with improving their writing and learnt about how to avoid comma splicing. I learnt lots just from talking to them and seeing the high quality of their writing.

There was much excitement in Little Gems as the children made traps for the Gingerbread Man and on Wednesday morning they caught him! It was such a pleasure seeing the excitement on the children's faces and how thrilled they are with their learning about the traditional story of the Gingerbread Man.
