Communication & Language

Children will talk about themselves and their families using describing words. They will imagine and recreate roles in real life family situations. They will ask questions to get to know their friends.

Literacy

The children will learn to recognise and write their names as well as familiar words such as mum, dad. We will begin our daily RWI (phonics) lessons and learn Set One sounds. The children have access to fiction and non-fiction texts relating to our topic and will participate in daily story times.

34 Maths

To begin, we will build on previous experiences of numbers. Children will develop subitising and counting skills with a focus on 1-5. We will also compare sets of objects.

Physical Development

We will play cooperation games.
Children will learn about how to keep healthy. We will be moving with control and coordination to go over, under, through and around various apparatus.
We will participate in two PE sessions per week.



We will start the year with the topic "Me and My Family" where the children will be talking about themselves and their families. We will be using all five senses to investigate the area around us, and we will be learning how families can have similarities and differences.

Personal & Social Development

We will create class rules, learn the routines of the school day and participate in turn taking games. The children will try out new activities and select resources independently.

PSHE topics will focus on: "all about me", "my special people" and "my feelings"

Expressive Arts and Design

We will draw self-portraits, and pictures of families and friends,

We will use paint and mix colours.

We will make collages and models with different materials. We will sing a range of songs to help us in our learning.

Children will represent their own ideas and feeling through art, design, music,



dance and role-play.

How to help your child

- Phonics: complete homework sheets to reinforce the letter sounds we have learnt each week
- Names: help the children to read and write their first name, each letter correctly formed, with a capital only for the initial letter
- Story time: try to read story books as often as you can
- Counting to 10 and from 10 to zero
- Counting objects with accurate 1:1 correspondence
