## **Communication & Language**

Children will talk about themselves using describing words. They will imagine and recreate roles in real-life family situations.

They will ask questions to get to know their friends.



#### Literacy

The children will learn to recognise and write their names as well as familiar words such as mum, dad. The children have access to a range of books and daily story time. We will teach Phonics in groups where children will learn the initial sounds.



#### **Maths**

To begin, we will build on previous experiences of numbers. Children will develop subitising and counting skills with a focus on 1-5. We will also compare sets of objects.

## **Physical Development**

In their P.E. lesson children will be learning how to ride a bike with Nathan, our specialist P.E teacher. We will also be focusing on balance in class.



#### **Understanding the world**

We will start the year with the topic "All about me and my feelings" where the children will be talking about themselves and their families. With a focus on 'Zones of Regulation' the children will begin to name and work with their emotions & feelings.

Special People:

To begin, the children will talk about special people in their community. Then we will focus on Jesus and other special people in the Bible. We learn about harvest and why we celebrate this.

## **Expressive Arts and Design**

The children will gain new skills throughout each term. In the first term, we will focus on cutting, gluing and drawing on different materials and with different pencils. The children will draw self-portraits and pictures of their families and friends.

We will sing a range of songs to help us in our learning.

All children are invited to act out stories with finger puppets.



## **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**

We will create class rules, learn the routines of the school day and participate in turn taking games. The children will try out new activities and select resources independently.
